Please do not roll back AB 1788, AB 2552, or AB 1322. These were put in to protect wildlife and pets and avoid poisons that Californians have said they do not want used.

California should invest in ecological rodent control to protect raptors and predators, not more poison.

Anticoagulants are non-selective, killing wildlife that naturally control rodents. It also poisons household pets that may find poisoned rats or other wildlife. Allowing >100 days of poison use ensures continued contamination of predators, pets, and ecosystems.

You, the DPR, are legally obligated to protect wildlife, not poison it. Californians have already demanded poison-free solutions, so you must honor the law.
