I am strongly opposed to your proposal to allow the use of anticoagulant rodenticides for 105 days in a year. AB 1788, AB 2552, and AB 1322 were passed to protect wildlife, not poison it, and DPR should abide by them.

Anticoagulants are toxic and non-selective, killing the very wildlife that naturally controls rodents. They also endanger our children and pets that come into contact with poisoned rodents.

Please use your resources to work on poison-free solutions to protect raptors and other predators of rodents. There are much better options than toxic anticoagulant rodenticides.
