DPR: The modification/rollback of regulation of rodenticides as required in AB1788, AB2552 and AB1322 is going to have terrible consequences for the natural predatory food chain of California's wildlife. Allowing 100 days or more of anticoagulant rodenticides will have deathly outcomes for the owls, foxes, raptors and other natural predators of rodents long past 100 days. And, I have no faith that the 100 day limits will be monitored with any regularity or thoroughness.

California has been a leader in thoughtful management of wildlife and conservation management. The rollback of the above mentioned regulations is a cruel, harmful step backwards. I urge DPR to reconsider and continue full implementation of AB1788, AB2552 and AB1322.
