(Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to improve the existing US-36/SR-37 interchange at I-71 and construct a new multi-lane highway (Sunbury Parkway) from existing US 36 just west of Africa Road to South Wilson Road, just east of I-71 in southern Delaware County, Ohio. The application was submitted by Ohio Department of Transportation. The project is located at I-71, Africa/S Three Bs & K/Wilson Roads, Sunbury, OH, 43021. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2016-00872-SCR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 249176A1. Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of nine category 1 and seven category 2 wetlands, Alum Creek Reservoir, Johnson Run, and nine unnamed streams. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the certification, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
