Dear Board:

I so wanted to come by yesterday and comment of the priorities for 2026 but am under the weather.

Please accept this comment:

Even selection logging is a serious climate consideration.

For example, a recent plan to log 1099 acres on the Russian River admits it will take 88 years to recoup the carbon sequestration lost in the logging. 1-25NTMP-0001-SON Berry's Knotfarm.

Two Ph. D. Climate scientists (Evans and O'Brien) agree that it will take at least that long and likely longer insofar as trees are already starting to grow slower.....Even 88 years is an unmitigatable yet avoidable adverse cumulative impact. And a lot of logging is going on.

I look forward to hearing that you account for these cuts in your carbon Emissions and Sequestration models. To do less would be to sway the models in ways that underestimate our GHG equations. They won't be reliable. Thank you for your important work.
