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CARB must maintain the strongest possible emissions standards. The federal government's attempts to intervene in California regulation are illegal, and California's right to regulate emissions is long-standing and built on a solid legal foundation. All parties know this, therefore, California must ignore the federal government's intervention and continue to enforce California law, regardless of any illegitimate actions from Congress, the Executive branch, or the federal Kangaroo Court.

In addition, California should continue to strengthen its regulations, to provide a counterbalance against the attacks on clean air coming from the illegitimate squatter in the White House who is Constitutionally barred from holding office in the US per Amendment 14, Section 3. In the face of these attacks against all Americans, California can provide leadership and strengthen our rules, and those of other states, to provide a model for how America can be improved, rather than attacked.
