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Out of 342 million Americans, 99.9% rely entirely on public utilities for daily survival. While CA ACF rules rightly exempt police and fire vehicles, excluding utility trucks from these same exemptions is a critical oversight. Utility vehicles are frontline emergency responders. They are routinely dispatched for hours or days at a time to restore essential water, sewer, and power services. Blocking these vehicles compromises public health, and they should be permanently exempted to protect our most basic rights to life supporting infrastructure. This rule is a terrible distraction for the utilities and consumes their valuable resources that should be focused squarely on delivering services.
