## **Topic Introduction**

### **Topic Purpose and Lesson Overview**

The purpose of this topic is to address the WCAG requirement for Success Criteria (SC) 4.1.1 Parsing. The intent is to ensure that user agents, such as assistive technology, can accurately interpret and parse markup languages (html code). If the content cannot be parsed, different technologies may present code differently or be completely unable to present it. At this time, the Trusted Tester process has not identified a tool to adequately facilitate conformance validation for this particular requirement. Therefore, the test outcome for this test condition will be **NOT TESTED** until a test tool can be identified.

## **Lesson 1: Parsing**

#### **Test Requirement**
