In almost every category, there are more harmful "inerts" than active substances.OFPA allows the use of a synthetic substance in organic production only if it is listed on the National List "by specific use or application" based on a recommendation by the NOSB, following procedures in OFPA. The NOSB has repeatedly passed recommendations telling NOP to evaluate individual "inerts." In moving forward, there must be no more delay:
